- All Students will be assessed between April 07-15 and Oct 23-30 of every year for each of the honors program.
- Top 60% of students will be eligible for the Honors Enrollment.
- Parents to provide their consent for the Honors Program.
- Other students outside of top 60% will be in the waiting list
- In case of students & parents' consent denial, the wait list candidate will be given chance for the enrollment.

General Details, Program Rules & Regulations

Here is the Honors Excellence Program rules regulations and policies. All students, parents and program coordinator must refer this to ensure the smooth execution and successful of the honors curriculum of The SSSGVM.

• Every year, the start of the Hons Class is 16 April for Specialization Part – I and 01 November for Honors Specialization Part – II.

- All Selected students must report their homework and class work activities to their program coordinator/teacher without fail.
- Students within the Honors program will be evaluated every 6 months for their eligibility continuity for the respective Honors program
- The students who are not enrolled in the April-Oct Session will give another exam in October 23-30 for the Nov-March session to get enrolled into the program.
- The Honors enrolled students will be mandatorily attending the respective 40 minutes Honors class after school.
- Any single Hons class missed by the students, parents is to be notified and the absent excuse application to be submitted to Principal.
- If three continuous Honors class is skipped, then a final warning will be issued to de-enroll from Honors Curriculum. The candidate will be de-enrolled from Honors class if continuous 5 honors class is missed. The decision of Principal and Lead, Academic Excellence Tower and Dean will be final.
- Any honors enrolled student does not have the 75% of the attendance will be defaulted and requires separate recommendation letter from Principal, Lead, Academic Excellence approvals followed by CGB's Academic Director's Approval.
